Dear Jim,

In January of this year one of our board members shared his personal experience and passion for the Y saying, "The Y is a safe space for people to go." Little did we know how true that statement would ring just eight months later.

Through all the changes and challenges that 2020 has brought, the Y has continued to focus on what is most important – providing a safe experience for all, and supporting children, adults, families, and seniors.

In April, we launched Camp CARE (Childcare Assistance in Response to Emergency), providing COVID-19 compliant child care for working families in our county. By providing engaging out-of-school activities and learning support, we continue to ease the burden families are experiencing during school closures. We also launched half-day youth sports camps and clinics, supporting youth eager to engage in safe, healthy outdoor activities.

Our Y provides virtual and outdoors fitness options, and outreach to all of our older adult members to ensure they are safe and connected. We are doing what we can to provide opportunities for wellness, physical activity and community for all.

As our community continues to press on through the significant impacts of COVID-19, the Y needs your support to meet our mission.

In order to safely offer our community programs, and in accordance with CDC guidelines, we must operate with a smaller ratio of staff to participants, more facility space to ensure social distancing, and increased cleaning practices. These protocols result in higher costs, and in turn, more requests for financial assistance from families in need of support. Your contribution helps the Y subsidize these efforts so that more families are able to access and benefit from our programs.

Thanks to the CARES Act, 2020 is a very good year to donate. If you do not itemize your deductions, you are eligible for a deduction of \$300 on your 2020 taxes, and if you do itemize, you can deduct up to 100% of your Adjusted Gross Income for cash contributions. If you are over age 70 and make a contribution directly from a traditional IRA to the Y, you can donate up to \$100,000 without it being considered a taxable distribution. Lastly, donating appreciated stock continues to be good option.

Now, more than ever, the Y is a safe space for people to go. With your support, our Y can focus on doing what we do best – caring for our children and strengthening our community.
